\$1000 PRIZE

This year the **Kemper Human Rights Education Foundation** (khref.org) is offering a \$1000 first prize and a \$500 second prize to high school students from countries other than the United States judged to have written the best answers to the following question:

What is the most important human rights issue in your country and/or the world and what should be done about it?

RULES

DEADLINE: The deadline for submissions is November 22, 2017.

AWARDS: Winners will be announced on December 10, 2017, Human Rights Day.

LENGTH: Essays should be between 1000 and 2500 words with footnotes and a bibliography as needed.

CRITERIA: Essays will be judged according to how clearly and well they answer the question posed and the extent to which they are supported by research.

COVER PAGE: Submissions should include a cover page with the: title of the essay, author's name, high school address, teacher, grade level, date submitted, and the following signed statement: "I give the Kemper Human Rights Education Foundation permission to publish this essay."
